Riding tour 2016

Day 1 – Monday 4th of July: Arrival in the afternoon – welcome dinner

Arrival in the afternoon at Skeiðvellir at 18:00 (can be earlier and pick up from Hella can be arranged) Welcome dinner and get to know each other.

Day 2 – Tuesday 5th of July : Skeiðvellir – Hvammur

Breakfast in the morning and make a lunch pack to take with you for the day. This is a great start of the riding tour and we ride partly along the Þjórsá river with good view over mountains and glaciers. We leave the horses at Hvammur and drive back to the farm for accommodation and dinner in the evening. Duration 4 ½ - 5 hours. 24 km.



Day 3 – 6th of July : Hvammur – Skarfaneshvammur

Breakfast in the morning and make a lunch pack to take with you for the day. This day offers a huge contrast in the landscape riding through soft riding paths, riding along the river and through sand and lava. Great view over Mt. Hekla. We leave the horses at Hvammur and drive back to the farm to pack and get ready to take the bus to Reykjavík in the evening. Duration 5 - 6 hours. 30 km.

Our tours are based on personal and good service therefore we have decided to have the groups always small – max 10 persons. We use quality horses that are well trained and have good tölt. The tours are without a loose running herd. We also demand that our riders have some experience and we do not take along beginners on our tours.
